July 1, 2022, Miami – We're pleased to announce the winners of the 8<sup>th</sup> Art and Olfaction Awards, which took place at the World Perfumery Congress on July 1, 2022 in Miami.

The Art and Olfaction Awards, established in 2014 by *The Institute for Art and Olfaction*, are given to outstanding creators in the categories of independent, artisan, and experimental perfume from across the globe, chosen for perfumes and experimental projects with scent released in 2020 and 2021. In addition to those juried categories, the Art and Olfaction Awards honor excellent work with three discretionary awards: *The Contribution to Scent Culture Award*, *The Septimus Piesse Award for Exceptional Vision*, and the *Aftel Award for Handmade Perfume*.

This year's **Art and Olfaction Awards** marked a new collaboration between the Art and Olfaction Awards and the World Perfumery Congress (presented by the American Society for Perfumers). We believe that this collaboration is an important step in creating dialogue between different segments of the perfume industry. By placing independent, artisan and experimental practices with scent in the context of the larger industry, we hope to highlight the creative impulse that drives us all.

As with past years, our panel of exceptional judges included Anahita Mekanik, Andreas Keller, April Long, Ashley Eden Kessler, Chi Wai Tang, Dana El Masri, Daniel Krasofski, Darin Klein, Ida Meister, Jeanne Doré, John Biebel, Julianne Lee, Kaya Sorhaindo, Klara Ravat, Lakenda Wallace, Mandy Aftel, Mark Behnke, Matthias Tabert, Maxwell Williams, Rubia Chaudri, Sarah Horowitz-Thran, Simon Niedenthal, Yosh Han. These people served as judges for no personal gain, as a service to the community. Judging is blind in the artisan and independent categories, and for the Aftel Award for Handmade Perfume.

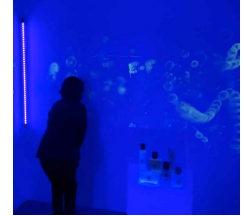


## SADAKICHI AWARD FOR EXPERIMENTAL WORK WITH SCENT WINNER
