The Institute for Art and Olfaction celebrates the finalists of the 10th Art and Olfaction Awards at a special event at Craft Contemporary, in Los Angeles.

April 19, Los Angeles ---- The Institute for Art and Olfaction is proud to announce the finalists for the 10th Art and Olfaction Awards.

Launched in 2014, the Art and Olfaction Awards have become a highly distinguished recognition of excellence in independent perfumery. This event aims to promote public interest and awareness of the latest developments in perfume and recognizes outstanding creators in the Independent, Artisan, and Experimental perfume categories. The awards acknowledge a diverse range of styles and techniques, honoring creators from various backgrounds, geographical locations, and perspectives.

THE GOLDEN PEAR

The Art and Olfaction Awards' Golden Pear statuette is presented annually to nine deserving recipients at events held in different cities across the globe. Through this recognition, the organization has helped to foster innovation and creativity in the art of perfumery, while inspiring a new generation of independent perfumers.

NINE AWARDS (INCLUDING THE INAUGURAL NEWCOMER AWARD)

Two awards are given in each of the three juried categories (Artisan category, Independent category, and the Sadakichi Award for Experimental Work with Scent). Awards are also given in four discretionary categories: the Contribution to Scent Culture Award, the Septimus Piesse Award for Exceptional Vision, the Aftel Award for Handmade Perfume and the Newcomer Award - a new category for 2024 - which will be presented to a perfume from a company that had its first launch in 2023.

THE 2024 ART+OLFACTION AWARDS CEREMONY IN LISBON

The announcement of the winners will take place in our annual public ceremony. This year we host our event in Lisbon at the stunning Casa do Alentejo, on June 7, 2024. The Awards

have become a gathering of some of the brightest names in independent perfumery, but maintain a familial tone, and are surrounded by programming and events, and as always, lots to smell.

THE EXPERIMENTAL SCENT SUMMIT

The awards will be preceded by the Experimental Scent Summit, in its fifth edition, a day of talks and round table discussions around new practices in scent that is curated by Klara Ravat, Miguel Matos, Julianne Lee, and Saskia Wilson-Brown.

OUR PANEL OF ESTEEMED JUDGES

As with past years, our panel of esteemed judges is comprised of important and objective voices from the perfume and art worlds. This year's jury includes Arabelle Sicardi, Dana Kiley Buchanan, Linda Srivican, Persephenie, Steven Gontarski, Terry Carter, and Tianna Blue. Together, these judges blindly selected the finalists in the artisan and independent categories.

The second-round judges are Anahita Mekanik, Chi-Wai Tang, Glenn Davis, Ida Meister, Lorenzo Cavallaro, Matthias Janke, Patrick Boateng II, and Spyros Drosopoulos, who blindly selected the winners in the Artisan and Independent categories.

The Sadakichi Award is juried by Andreas Keller, Kaya Sorhaindo, Maki Ueda, Simon Niedenthal and Sofia Ehrich. The Aftel Award for Handmade Perfume is selected in a separate blind judging process by Dr. Jessica Harris, Leslie Blodgett, and Mandy Aftel. The Newcomer Award is selected in a separate blind judging process by Antonio Gardoni, Christophe Laudamiel, and Marta Siembab.

DISCRETIONARY AWARDS

AFTEL AWARD FOR HANDMADE PERFUME

This award will be given to one outstanding small-batch perfume that was 100% perfumer-created, in-house, with no use of outsourced compounding or expansion at any stage of the process.

NEWCOMER AWARD

This award celebrates newcomers to the fragrance industry. It will be awarded to a perfume from a brand that launched its first fine fragrance product to market in 2023.

CONTRIBUTION TO SCENT CULTURE

This award will be given to one outstanding person who made significant contributions to global public awareness of artisan, independent, and experimental practices with scent in 2023.

SEPTIMUS PIESSE VISIONARY AWARD

This award is given to an outstanding person or group showing proof of exceptional vision with regard to how scent is used, developed, or imagined.

Winners in all categories will be announced at the 10th annual Art and Olfaction Awards on June 7, 2024, at Casa do Alentejo in Lisbon. The awards are open to the public with reservation: please visit thegoldenpears.com for more information.
